**VILLAGE OF MOUNT MORRIS
LOCAL LAW NO. __ OF 2026 ENTITLED
“OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN
GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-C.”**

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Board of the Village of Mount Morris as follows:

SECTION I. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

It is the intent of this Local Law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Village of Mount Morris, County of Livingston pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-C. and to allow the Village of Mount Morris, County of Livingston to adopt a Village budget for (a) Village purposes; (b) fire protection districts; and (c) any other special or improvement district governed by the Village Board for the 2026 – 2027 fiscal year that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law §3-C.

SECTION II. AUTHORITY

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-C. which expressly authorizes the Village Board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Village Board.

SECTION III. TAX LEVY LIMIT OVERRIDE

The Village Board of the Village of Mount Morris, County of Livingston is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the 2026 – 2027 fiscal year that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law §3-C.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
